

## Nearest the Pin Clarification.

**When a player becomes a nearest the pin contender, then the following should take place:-**

- a) Get confirmation from other players in your group that your ball is the closest to the hole.
- b) Where appropriate measure and write the distance from the front of the ball to the front edge of the hole or write "as marked"
- c) Before putting place a ball marker near where the ball is.
- d) After putting out insert the nearest the pin marker where the ball was initially putted from.(front of marker = front of ball)
- e) Write your name onto the NP card and have a witness from your group sign the NP Card.

**Note.** Should you or your marker forget to fill out the NP Card, then you have limited time to go back and complete this task.

As a rule once following players have entered the NP green or you have hit off on the next tee, then it is too late to go back and try to correct the situation.
